

Best Book Award - 2012

Prof. (Dr.) Sadhan Chandra Ray is a Professor in Fabric Manufacture at the Department of Jute and Fibre Technology, University of Calcutta, India. After graduation in Textile Technology from the University of Calcutta in 1976 and with a short exposure in Textile Industry, he started his career in teaching. He obtained his M. Tech. (Textile Engineering) and Ph. D. (Knitting Technology) Degrees from Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi.

He has about thirty years' experience in teaching of textiles including research. He is also guiding research projects leading to Ph. D. degree.

Apart from his teaching and research work he is the author of more than fifty five publications in different journals and books of papers of the seminars/conferences and two small books – a) Training Manual on Jute Winding and b) Technical Handbook on Factory Side Machinery of Jute mills. Very recently his book – “Fundamentals and Advances in Knitting Technology” has been published jointly by Woodhead Publishing India and Woodhead Publishing UK.

Presently he is the member of the Editorial Board of the many esteemed journals and is associated with many professional bodies such as Life Fellow Member of the Institution of Engineers, Patron Member of The Textile Association (India), Life Member of Indian Society for Technical Education (ISTE) and Life Member of Crop & Weed Science Society, BCKV, W.B.
